Guidelines

Music Events

- Light / Folk Music (Vocal): Bollywood and Hollywood songs are not allowed, Karaoke /Track not allowed.
- Light/Folk/Western Music (Vocal): Orchestra will be provided. Participants can use their own instrument also. Western Music (Vocal): Karaoke/ Track allowed. Besides Hindi all the western languages are allowed.
- Classical Music (Instrumental): Participants must bring their own instruments and two accompanists are allowed . Organizers can provide two accompanists on demand and on prior information.
- Classical Music (Vocal / Instrumental): Hindustani Northern & Karnataka music.

Dance Events

- Wardrobe malfunctioning will result in immediate disqualification.
- Classical Dance: 3-accompanists allowed / can perform on recorded music also.
- The performance should not reflect aspersions on any caste, religion, gender or race.
- Western Dance: Variety of dance forms in the performance will be given credit.

Theater Events

- Theme is open for all the events.
- The script of the street play should not reflect aspersions on any caste, religion, gender or race.
- Copy of the script should be submitted to our office by the team manager on or before 12th February 2020.
- The participant on shall be cancelled if the costume is not found suitable for the presentation.
- No vulgar/offensive/ abusive dialogues/recorded music shall be used by the participants. Such behaviour shall result in immediate disqualification.

Arts/Drawing & Painting events

- The topic of these competitions shall be declared on the spot.
- The participants have to bring their own material/tools (paint, brush, colours for Rangoli/Mandana, instruments for clay modelling, mehandi cones for mehandi competition etc.
- Drawing sheets/clay/T-shirt will be provided.
- Acrylic/water colour can be used.
- For Face Painting: The Participant can paint her/his own face or any other person's.
- For Mehendi: Participant can apply on their own hand or any other person's.

Literary Events

Debate Topic:

English: In the opinion of the house, "Gandhi Darshan is only solution for uprooting of terrorism"

हिन्दी : इस सदन की राय में, "समान नागरिक संहिता वर्तमान भारतीय परिस्थितियों के लिए अनुकूल नहीं है"

- Content should be original with self-expression.
- The poem must be self-written.
- The script should not reflect aspersions on any caste, religion, gender or race.
- Topic for essay will be announced on 14th Feb.

Bait Baazi

- Couplet must start from the last letter (Suffix/AI)
- Each contestant must read at least two couplets.
- The couplet should not reflect aspersions on any caste, religion, gender or race.

Mr. Ghoomar/ Ghoomar Queen

- Costume must be dignified.
- There will be three rounds - i. Introductory round, ii.
- Talent round, iii. Question round (both G.K. and General).

Rules

- Team should not exceed 20 participants. One male and one female teacher, if co-education otherwise only one male or one female teacher as team manager is allowed.
- No Registration on fee for Participation. Certificate will be provided for participants on and winners both.
- Those who have already been Miss and Mr. Ghoomar in the previous years can not participate for the title again, while the winners of Mr. and Ms. Youth are allowed to participate in Mr. and Ms. Ghoomar 2020, only once.
- No financial support will be provided from DSW Office, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur to the team.
- Hospitality will given by the organizers from 13th to 15th Feb. 2020.
- All the participants must be regular students and must carry their identity card. Photocopy duly attested by the authority is required at the me of registration. For accompanists, authority letter from the Registrar/ DSW/Authority is compulsory.
- The last date for receiving consent is 10th February, 2020. Scanned copy of registration form duly signed by Registrar/DSW/ Authority is compulsory along with the registration through mail adswuniraj@gmail.com (registration form enclosed).
- All the participants shall abide by the rules and regulations as stipulated by our university.
- Smoking and consumption of alcoholic drinks is strictly prohibited.
- In case of any misbehaviour or indiscipline by the participants or the concerned team members is found, disciplinary action will be taken/ participation can be disqualified.
- Decision of the judges will be final.
